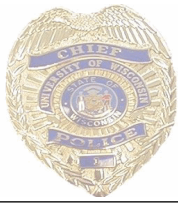

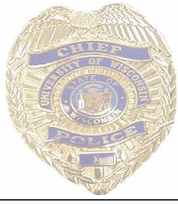

BWC Activated

On Monday, September 23rd, 2019 at approximately 5:00PM, Officer Campbell and I (Officer Weaver) were dispatched to a vehicle accident that occurred outside of Enderis Hall, located at 2400 E. Hartford Ave. (Milwaukee, W).

Upon arrival, I observed a UWM GO Riteway Shuttle Bus (WI State Plates 22282B) parked in the eastbound lane with the hazards on and a crowd of approximately 20-30 people waiting to get onto the shuttle. There was damage to the rear driver side bumper and debris on the street. At this time, I did not observe the second vehicle and walked towards the crowd of people to ask about injuries. Some of the people in the crowd pointed towards a BMW Convertible (WI Plates [REDACTED]). I observed the BMW Convertible parked in the grass with the front driver tire in the raised flower bed. The BMW was crowded by approximately five people standing around the BMW.

I made contact with the operator for the BMW, [REDACTED] (WI DL), who was breathing and conscious. Due to the condition of the BMW and [REDACTED] seeming confused, I requested for Emergency Medical Service (EMS). I asked [REDACTED] if he knew his name and he was able answer the question correctly. When asked where his pain was, he stated it was in his back. [REDACTED] stated his legs were “tingly” and starting to go numb. While Officer Campbell continued to talk to [REDACTED], I went back to the Go Riteway Shuttle to see if there were any more injuries.

I spoke with the Go Riteway Shuttle operator, [REDACTED] (WI DL), who stated he was not injured and did not need medical attention. I spoke with the only passenger, [REDACTED] who stated she was not injured and did not need medical attention. I asked [REDACTED] if he had spoken with his supervisor regarding the shuttle bus, which he stated yes. [REDACTED]'s supervisor, Daniel T. CRAMER (verbally identified), was on his way to the accident.

I repositioned my squad on E. Hartford Ave. at N. Maryland Ave. (Milwaukee, WI) to block the eastbound traffic. I requested another squad to position themselves on E. Hartford Ave. at N. Downer Ave. (Milwaukee, WI) to shut down the westbound lane of traffic. Officer Parsons assisted with traffic control. I requested UWM Dispatch to advise UWM Transportation and the Milwaukee County Transit System (MCTS) about the road closure.

At approximately 5:05PM, Milwaukee Fire Department (MFD) Engine #27 arrived on scene to assess [REDACTED]

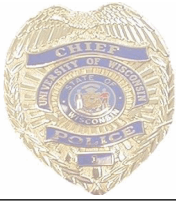
When CRAMER arrived on scene, I spoke with him regarding the shuttle bus. CRAMER stated he requested a tow to transport the shuttle bus to the repair shop. CRAMER stated he would drive the shuttle bus to the Klotsche parking lot, located at 3409 N. Downer Ave., to remove it from the lane of traffic while waiting for the tow. Officer Campbell advised Medacare 274 arrived on scene and stated [REDACTED] would be transported Columbia St. Mary’s, located at 2323 N. Lake Dr. (Milwaukee, WI). All City Towing was en route to tow the BMW. While waiting for the BMW and shuttle bus to be towed, Officer Campbell took pictures of the damage. Please see his supplement for a photograph log.

I spoke with Serena A. FALK (verbally identified), who stated she saw the accident. FALK stated she observed the shuttle bus come to a stop with their hazards on. FALK stated she observed the BMW failed to stop and hit the shuttle bus. FALK believed the operator of the BMW was not paying attention.

Shortly after, the shuttle bus was removed from the scene along with the BMW. Officer Parsons and I removed our squad blocking traffic to open up the street. I asked UWM dispatch to contact UWM Transportation and MCTS to inform them the road was back open.

[REDACTED]'s one citation (inattentive driving) was placed in the UWM outgoing mail. DT4000 was completed. The estimated cost of damages to the shuttle bus is over \$1000 and the estimated cost of damages to the

Supplement Narrative

On Sunday, September 29th, 2019 at approximately 8:30PM, I, PO Weaver, spoke with [REDACTED] regarding the accident via telephone. [REDACTED] stated he was wearing Nike Slide sandals during the accident. [REDACTED] stated that his dominate driving foot is his right foot. He also stated that the sandals he was wearing was ripped on his right foot. He stated he was approximately 5-10 feet away from the bus when he observed it stop. [REDACTED] stated he went to use his left foot to apply pressure on the breaks, however his right sandal got caught on the gas pedal. This made the vehicle accelerate. [REDACTED] stated the last thing he remembered was the front window glass breaking and then waking up to the vehicle parked off of the road.

[REDACTED] stated he has insurance and was going to send a copy of his insurance to my email. [REDACTED] also stated he would include a picture of his broken sandals. I informed [REDACTED] of the two citations and explained that if he was not able to provide the insurance information, he would be receiving another one for no insurance.

A few days later, [REDACTED] provided me with his insurance information. He is insured through Geico.
